1 Attention

Do not trailer with The Deflector mounted.

The Deflector is designed to be easy to install and remove from your boat. The Deflector is designed for max speeds of 13mph or 21kph. Anything in excess of the max speed can result in the Deflector coming off. The Deflector coming off can be dangerous. A cleat leash is provided to keep The Deflector close to the boat in case of coming off. Use at your own discretion.

Roswell is not responsible for lost Deflectors, damage to boats caused by the Deflector coming off or damage to boats from using the provided cleat leash.

Follow these steps to ensure proper installation of your Deflector Wave Shaper.



Deflector Installation Instructions

Decide if you want to use the Deflector cleat leash. The Deflector does float if it unintentionally comes off. However, a cleat leash is provided to keep the Deflector close to the boat if it does come off. Use at your own discretion. Location of cleats differ from one boat to another. Deflector being pulled by the leash can cause Deflector to hit the boat and/or prop causing damage. Roswell is not responsible for boat damage due to use of cleat leash.

If using cleat leash follow these 2 steps. If not, move on to Step C
